# Traffic Report | February 2024

#### Passengers increased 22.3%, reaching an 85.2% Load Factor

**Mexico City, March 8, 2024** – Viva Aerobus announced today its February 2024 preliminary traffic results. Viva Aerobus' passenger traffic increased 22.3% compared to February 2023, reaching 1.9 million passengers, driven by an increase of 23.9% and 8.5% in domestic and international traffic, respectively. Load factors reached 85.2% compared to 83.6% in 2023, with a load factor mix of 88.0% and 72.8% in domestic and international, respectively.

Viva Aerobus grew its total capacity in available seat miles (ASMs) by 21.2% compared to February 2023, reflecting an increase of 22.4% and 15.8% in domestic and international, respectively.

"As a result of the favorable market dynamics in the Mexican market, our load factors remained healthy at 85%, increasing 1.6pp in one of the slowest seasonal months in Mexico. After a positive performance in 2023, we have had a solid start to the year despite continued challenges from the Pratt & Whitney GTF preventive engine inspections, reinforcing our commitment to disciplined capacity deployement and ensuring operational reliability" said Juan Carlos Zuazua, CEO of Viva Aerobus

### Glossary

Passengers: Customers who purchased their plane ticket to fly during the month referred in the report, regardless of whether they flew or not.

ASMs: Stands for "available seat miles" and represents the number of seats available for passengers multiplied by the number of miles.

Load Factor: Represents the number of miles flown by passenger (RPMs) divided by available seat miles (ASMs) and expressed as a percentage.

RPMs: Stands for "revenue passenger miles" and represents the number of miles flown by passengers.
