

Traffic Report | November 2025

Passengers increased 4.8%, reaching an 85.2% load factor

Mexico City, December 11, 2025 – Viva announced today its November 2025 preliminary traffic results. Viva's passenger traffic increased 4.8% compared to November 2024, reaching 2.6 million passengers.

Viva grew its total capacity in available seat miles (ASMs) by 4.9% compared to November 2024, reflecting an increase of 5.1% in domestic capacity and an increase of 3.7% in international. Load factors stood at 85.2% from 87.4% in 2024, with a load factor of 86.8% and 78.0% in domestic and international, respectively.

"During November, passenger volumes grew 4.8%, achieving an 85.2% load factor. This performance was mainly driven by the continued resilience of our core domestic market, providing a strong volume base as we enter the peak holiday travel period. While the operational environment remains constrained by engine availability issues, we continue to prioritize operational stability and disciplined execution to ensure reliable service during the holiday season.", said Juan Carlos Zuazua, CEO of Viva.

Glossary

Passengers: Customers who purchased their plane ticket to fly during the month referred in the report, regardless of whether they flew or not.

ASMs: Stands for "available seat miles" and represents the number of seats available for passengers multiplied by the number of miles.

Load Factor: Represents the number of miles flown by scheduled passengers (RPMs) divided by scheduled available seat miles (ASMs) and expressed as a percentage.

RPMs: Stands for "revenue passenger miles" and represents the number of miles flown by passengers.
