

# Traffic Report | April 2026

Passengers decreased 7.1%, reaching an 84.1% load factor

**Mexico City, May 12, 2026** – Viva announced today its April 2026 preliminary traffic results. Viva's passenger traffic contracted 7.1% compared to April 2025, reaching 2.3 million passengers.

Total capacity in available seat miles (ASMs) decreased 7.8% compared to April 2025, reflecting a 4.6% reduction in domestic capacity and a 20.8% decrease in international capacity. Network load factor closed at 84.1%, with domestic and international load factors of 85.7% and 76.3%, respectively.

"Passenger volumes decreased by 7.1% during April, with a load factor of 84.1%. These results reflect proactive capacity adjustments to align with the current macroeconomic environment and elevated fuel prices. In this context, we remain committed to a disciplined operational approach, prioritizing reliability as we manage ongoing Pratt & Whitney engine groundings and closely monitor market conditions amid a cautious consumer backdrop", said Juan Carlos Zuazua, CEO of Viva.

## Glossary

**Passengers:** Customers who purchased their plane ticket to fly during the month referred in the report, regardless of whether they flew or not.

**ASMs:** Stands for "available seat miles" and represents the number of seats available for passengers multiplied by the number of miles.

**Load Factor:** Represents the number of miles flown by scheduled passengers (RPMs) divided by scheduled available seat miles (ASMs) and expressed as a percentage.

**RPMs:** Stands for "revenue passenger miles" and represents the number of miles flown by passengers.
