

Traffic Report | June 2026

Passengers decreased 2.4%, reaching an 84.6% load factor

Mexico City, July 10, 2026 – Viva announced today its June 2026 preliminary traffic results. Viva's passenger traffic declined 2.4% compared to June 2025, transporting 2.4 million passengers.

Total capacity in available seat miles (ASMs) decreased 4.1% compared to June 2025, reflecting a 4.8% reduction in domestic capacity and a 1.2% decrease in international capacity. Network load factor reached 84.6%, with domestic and international load factors of 85.9% and 78.6%, respectively.

"During June, we maintained a disciplined approach to capacity deployment amid a softer macroeconomic environment and elevated fuel prices, while demand patterns were also affected by travel trends associated with the FIFA World Cup. In line with broader industry trends, passenger volumes declined 2.4%, while our load factor stood at 84.6%. Looking ahead, we will continue to prioritize operational reliability and adjust our network to prevailing demand conditions, while ongoing Pratt & Whitney engine groundings continue to constrain fleet availability", said Juan Carlos Zuazua, CEO of Viva.

Glossary

Passengers: Customers who purchased their plane ticket to fly during the month referred in the report, regardless of whether they flew or not.

ASMs: Stands for "available seat miles" and represents the number of seats available for passengers multiplied by the number of miles.

Load Factor: Represents the number of miles flown by scheduled passengers (RPMs) divided by scheduled available seat miles (ASMs) and expressed as a percentage.

RPMs: Stands for "revenue passenger miles" and represents the number of miles flown by passengers.
