

Traffic Report | August 2026

Passengers decreased 1.2%, while the load factor increased to 89.8%

Mexico City, September 11, 2026 – Viva announced today its August 2026 preliminary traffic results. Viva transported 2.7 million passengers in August 2026, a decrease of 1.2% compared to August 2025.

Total capacity in available seat miles (ASMs) decreased 3.5% compared to August 2025, reflecting a reduction of 4.0% in domestic capacity and 1.0% in international capacity. Network load factor increased to 89.8%, with domestic and international load factors of 90.9% and 84.7%, respectively.

“During August, we continued to proactively align our network with evolving demand conditions, consistent with the disciplined approach we have maintained throughout the year. Passenger volumes decreased 1.2%, while our load factor improved to 89.8%, supported by the effectiveness of our network adjustments. With fuel costs remaining elevated and Pratt & Whitney engine groundings continuing to constrain fleet availability, we will remain focused on the factors within our control, including disciplined capacity management and operational reliability, while preserving liquidity”, said Juan Carlos Zuazua, CEO of Viva.

Glossary

Passengers: Customers who purchased their plane ticket to fly during the month referred in the report, regardless of whether they flew or not.

ASMs: Stands for "available seat miles" and represents the number of seats available for passengers multiplied by the number of miles.

Load Factor: Represents the number of miles flown by scheduled passengers (RPMs) divided by scheduled available seat miles (ASMs) and expressed as a percentage.

RPMs: Stands for "revenue passenger miles" and represents the number of miles flown by passengers.
