The new plant’s HPDC technology will support the production of aluminum automotive components, primarily engine blocks, transmission cases, and structural components. Additionally, the plant will feature a machining center for processing these components. The total investment amounts to US\$200 million, with series production to begin in the first semester of the year.
