



Nemak receives top rating from CDP; recognized as global leader in managing climate change for the second consecutive year

- Nemak received, for the second consecutive year, an "A" rating for its actions with suppliers to address climate change.
- With this rating, it remains part of a select group of companies recognized by the CDP as leaders in such efforts.
- Only 8% of the companies that report to the CDP receive this recognition.

("Nemak" or the "Company") (BMV: NEMAK), a leading provider of innovative lightweighting solutions for the global automotive industry, announced today that it has received the CDP's top Supplier Engagement Rating of "A" for its steps to actively engage with its suppliers to manage climate change.

With this rating, Nemak remains part of the CDP's Supplier Engagement Leaderboard, which includes companies that are pioneers in driving the transformation of their businesses towards a zero-emissions future. Only 8% of the companies that report to the CDP belong to this group.

"We're delighted to have earned a place on this leaderboard. This recognition reflects our efforts to measure and reduce climate risk within our supply chain and our overall commitment to make sustainable mobility possible," said Armando Tamez, CEO of Nemak.

In addition to this rating, Nemak received a score of "B" in the CDP's overall climate change evaluation, which places it above the North American regional average as well as the average for the Company's sector.

As part of its efforts to address effects of climate change, Nemak has established targets to reduce its Scope 1 and 2 emissions by 28% by 2030 compared to a 2019 baseline. Moreover, the Company seeks to become net-carbon neutral by the year 2050 or earlier.
